The cost of this clinic is \$20. All proceeds will go to the equipment fund of the Shawnee Heights Softball team.

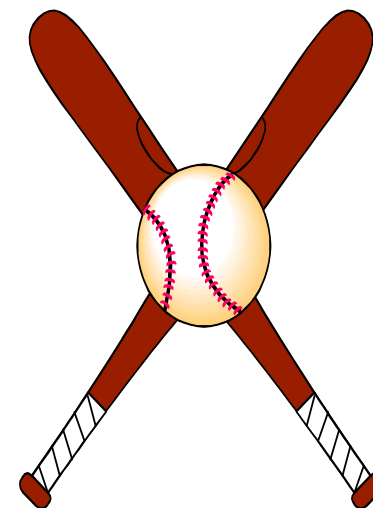
